

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

American Structurepoint, Inc., acting on behalf of the Town of Avon, will hold a public information meeting for the Dan Jones Road Widening Phase 4 Project (Des. No. 2401FFE) **Monday, December 8, at 6:00 pm.** The public information meeting will commence promptly at 6:00 PM with a presentation followed by an open house that will conclude at 7:30 PM. The meeting will be held at Avon High School, located at 7575 East County Road 150 South, Avon, Indiana. Meeting materials will be posted to the website by December 8, 2025. All comments are requested by January 8, 2025.

The purpose of the public information meeting is to offer all interested persons an opportunity to review and comment on the project. The proposed project area is located along Dan Jones Road (N CR 800 E) in Avon, Hendricks County, Indiana. The proposed project limits begin approximately 0.14 miles south of the intersection of Dan Jones Road and Bradford Road (E CR 200 S) and extends north to approximately 200 feet south of the intersection of Dan Jones Road and Oriole Way (E CR 150 S). The current proposed project would include the reconstruction of Dan Jones Rd from a 2-lane roadway to a 4-lane roadway. At the intersection of Dan Jones Rd and Bradford Rd, approximately 140 feet of Bradford Rd would be constructed west past the existing roundabout to possibly extend the roadway in the future. The typical roadway section on Dan Jones Rd is anticipated to consist of four, 12-foot-wide travel lanes (two northbound and two southbound), with a 14-foot-wide raised median and a curb and gutter. The 14-foot raised median would transition to a left-turn lane at Oriole Point Drive. Additionally, a 10-foot-wide multi-use path would be constructed on the eastern side of the roadway and a 6-foot-wide sidewalk on the west side of the roadway. The sidewalk and multi-use path would be separated from the road by 5-foot-wide grass buffer strips. Upgrades to the existing or new storm sewer would be installed to collect drainage from the curb and gutter. The proposed typical section would match the existing typical section to the north and tie into the existing 2-lane section at the intersection of Bradford Road to the south.

The maintenance of traffic plan is for this project to be a full lane closure with a detour during the construction period. Access to all properties will be maintained throughout construction. Project stakeholders including local school corporation(s) and emergency services will be notified of potential closures and/or detours prior to any construction. Construction of the project will require new permanent right-of-way. Local and State funds are to be utilized for the construction of the project.

With advance notice, the Town of Avon can provide special accommodation for persons with differing abilities, limited English speaking ability, and/or persons needing auxiliary aids or services such as interpreters, signers, readers, or large print.
